Scoring

One archer on the target will still need to paper score (in the event of any discrepancies the paper score sheet will be used as the official result).

The archer paper scoring should call the end scores/totals and the electronic scorer should confirm it is correct before moving to the next archer.

At the completion of the event archers are to fully complete and sign the paper score sheet and check that it is the same as the electronic results for each archer on the target.

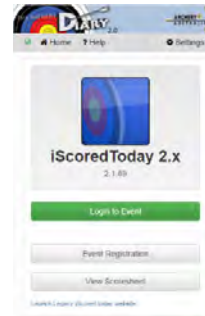
The new iScore.today application is a web-based application that can be used for **both** online (live) and offline (disconnected) scoring.
