MPB Membership Medallion

In recognition of their long-term commitment to the Club and the sport of archery, the Mount Petrie Bowmen (MPB) membership medallion will be presented to members who have maintained full membership of the Club and Archery Australia (AA) for a continuous period of five years.

Eligibility to Receive A Medallion

- recipients will be a current full MPB and AA member at 1 December for five continuous years
- medallions will not be presented retrospectively, ie, for previous members who are no longer financial, or for aggregated periods of membership exceeding five years
- medallions will be presented annually
- each medallion will have a number on the reverse. The order in which the medallions are issued will be determined by seniority of duration of continuous membership of MPB and AA
- for members who transfer membership from another AA club to MPB, the date of joining MPB will be used to determine their entitlement to receive a medallion
- where a membership lapses and the archer re-joins in line with AA rules for recognising a continuous membership, the original date of joining MPB will be used to determine the eligible commencement date
- the medallion has been designed so it can be attached to a quiver
- replacement medallions will be available for purchase at a cost of \$20.00.
 Replacement medallions will not be engraved. Members may have replacement medallions engraved at their expense
- MPB will maintain a register of the medallions issued.

This policy was approved by the Management Committee of Mount Petrie Bowmen Inc. on 17 March 2025. It will be reviewed annually, or at the discretion of the MPB Committee.
